### LOT 509

A Victorian gold ring, mounted with a row of five graduated varicoloured cabochon gemstones, inscribed within the shank '25th February 1871', detailed '18 S.W', weight 4.7g, ring size approx P1/2.

### Condition Report

All the stones are cabochons.

The smallest translucent/opaque stone on one end has taken a knock and is bruised.

The central stone is also fairly rubbed/abraded. The other three have some slight scuffing/rubbing.

Our opinion of what the stones are, from left to right: sapphire, jasper, garnet, banded agate, lapis lazuli. These are opinions only, the sapphire/garnet could be pastes.

Possibly resized in the past.

The '18' mark is likely its gold grade. The 'SW' will likely be a maker's mark.

Typical light scratching/rubbing to the shank and setting.
