A gold ring, late 18th century, glazed with an oval portrait miniature of a lady between scrolled shoulders, unmarked, weight 2g, ring size approx H1/2, with a case.

Estimate: £200 - £300

Condition Report

Some craquelure to the watercolour, some slight fading and surface dirt trapped between the watercolour and glazing. Some very minor rubbing.

The glazing has some scuffing/scratching. There is a slight dent to the side of the back of the shank, but the setting/shank is generally in good condition.

The portrait is likely to be of Mary, Queen of Scots, after the painting by Bernard Lens.
