An impressive Victorian ebonized and brass mounted bracket clock with eight day triple fusee movement chiming quarters on eight bells and striking hours on a gong, the engraved brass rectangular dial with silvered chime/silent, pendulum regulation and chime selection subsidiary dials above a silvered chapter ring with black Roman hour numerals, the case with pineapple finials above a glazed front door, flanked by a pair of caryatid and floral cast corner columns, the sides with pierced fret panels and handles, on a rectangular plinth base and cast scroll feet, the front applied with presentation plaque, height 62.5cm, with pendulum and winder.

Estimate: £1,500 - £2,500

Condition Report

1253. This impressive boardroom/bracket clock is in generally good condition with no significant damage or repairs. A bit dusty and dirty so would certainly benefit from a clean.

Typical minor nicks, scuffs and scratches to case, all metalwork mounts are present and secure. Minor chips to lock edge of back door, but nothing significant. Both hinged doors are good. Glass panel to front door has been later secured with plaster of Paris.

All three train movements wind smoothly and the clock is running, the chiming on bells mechanism is working nicely and the hour gong strike is also in good working order, but please be aware we give no guarantees to working order or reliability of any clock or watch.
