LOT 635

A diamond and black onyx brooch, designed as a begging terrier, mounted with circular cut diamonds, otherwise with black onyx highlights, unmarked, weight 6.9g, width 3.3cm, with an associated case.

Estimate: £600 - £800

Condition Report

Dimensions of brooch: 3.3cm x 1.9cm

The bottom of the brooch is likely onyx, with a slightly brownish tint to the stone, with some chipping to the far edge on the right side.

The remaining black areas of the brooch are black enamel. There are some losses to the black enamel on the tail, with a number of scratches to the enamel to the dog's back and a small chip to the enamel at the very outer edge in this area which is hard to see without a loupe.

All diamonds present. Two have chips to the sides of the tables. Stones look to be on average VS2/SI1 clarity and fairly bright white looking stones.

Pin is in working order.

Typical light scratching/wear overall, one or two insignificant small dents to the edges of the metalwork.
