A pair of Doulton Lambeth stoneware jardinières, late 19th century, decorated by Hannah Barlow, monogrammed, with landscape views of cattle and sheep, one with a figure rowing a boat on a river, between relief borders and a foliate scroll band, impressed and incised marks to bases, height 16cm (one with chip to inner rim edge).

Estimate: £400 - £600

Condition Report

Example with rowing boat - in good condition overall with no cracks, chips or restoration. A row of 5 tiny beads are missing from the banded decoration to the shoulders of the jardiniere.

Other pot - there is an approx 1.5cm long by 1cm deep flat chip to the inner top edge of the rim, it just encroaches onto the top rim edge. Otherwise in good condition overall with no cracks, chips or restoration.
