### LOT 1847

A pair of amber tinted crackle or ice glass enamelled vases, probably Czechoslovakian in the style of Moser, early 20th century, of baluster shape with long stems of white blossoming branches, height 22cm, together with a similar cranberry tinted ice glass vase with Aesthetic type enamelled decoration, height 14.5cm. Provenance: from the collection of John and Poppy Stallebrass.

### Condition Report

Pair - one has a minute nick to the outer rim edge of the neck, the other has a slight unevenness in the same place as a result of the uneven texture of the 'ice' ground. Otherwise both in good condition.

Single - some gilt details to the main body are completely rubbed, the enamelled ribbon decoration has firing cracks and a number of surface blemishes as a result of its manufacture.
