An early 19th century provincial oak longcase clock with thirty-hour movement striking on a bell, the painted dial inscribed 'Lewitt Leicester', the case with overall mahogany crossbanding, height 213cm, width 50cm, with pendulum and weight (alterations).

Condition Report

2002. Please be aware we give no guarantees to working order or reliability of any clock or watch. Movement looks relatively clean, it has been altered from an 8 day movement at some stage and has two filled-on holes on the dial.

The clock will certainly need some level of work, and at least a set-up once in place.

The case has a repair to the right side swan neck, a split to the right side of the case and some gapping to the timbers on the front panel of the base.
