A Japanese Satsuma earthenware jar by Kinkozan, Meiji period, of ovoid form, finely painted and gilt with bands of figures, cranes flying above waves and precious vessels between simulated brocade and floral borders, impressed Kinkozan seal mark to base, height 9cm (hairline crack to rim and lacking cover).

1139. Small chip to rim and hairline crack running vertically to nearly the base of the jar. No cover. Good vibrant decoration and gilt with only very minor wear. Typical light crazing visible to base.
