A gold backed, diamond, emerald and seed pearl brooch, circa 1900, in a scroll pierced and foliate design, mounted with the large emerald to the centre, with a seed pearl drop to the front, otherwise mounted with cushion cut diamonds, unmarked, weight 9.9g, emerald weight approx 2.50ct, width 4.5cm, with an associated Garrard & Co Ltd case.

Condition Report

657. Central flower finial slightly pushed to one side and scroll to right of centre pushed towards pin. Emerald has scratch to table facet. Table facet edges and edges to corners with slight wear. Small chip to emerald on the long lower edge. Emerald is of medium to pale colour saturation, but looks fairly clear.

Some diamonds drawing colour and have a few piqué inclusions.

Lacking safety chain.

Cultured pearl drop in good condition.
