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### Condition Report

8. In good condition. Some splitting and separation to dark areas of paint. Craquelure throughout. Some paint loss to left hand edge. Thick, uneven and dulling varnish blooms under UV, hindering overpainting examination. Minor surface dirt and therefore would benefit from a clean. The panel is bowing ever so slightly. Later repainted gilt frame is in very poor condition.

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
