### LOT 467

A Robert Welch part canteen of silver Alveston pattern cutlery, comprising three serving spoons, six tablespoons and forks, six dessert spoons and forks, six teaspoons, total weight 1554.8g, and six silver handled table knives and dessert knives, each with a steel blade, Sheffield 1967 and 1972 by Robert Welch, within a hardwood canteen case.

### Condition Report

467. All in generally good condition with no significant damage or repairs. Typical light surface scratches and wear from use. Some minor misshaping to some forks. No inscriptions, initials or erasures. Some pieces a little dirty so would certainly benefit from a clean. Good clear hallmarks. The case is in generally good order with typical minor scuffs, scratches and wear, but hinges are good and doors close tightly. Interior a little dirty and would benefit from a clean.

Please note almost all of the pieces have the 'RW' maker's mark and the Old Hall Tableware 'OHT' mark to the hallmark except for the three serving spoons which just have the 'OHT' mark in the hallmarks.
