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A late Victorian 18ct gold and diamond ring in a twin cluster design, mounted with cushion cut diamonds between decorated shoulders, Birmingham 1891, weight 3.1g, ring size approx S.

Estimate: £250 - £350

Condition Report

Some variation of cut to the stones, some cushion shaped, others oval. One appears more like a rose cut. A few of the diamonds have chips or nibbles. The larger diamonds are SI2/I1 clarity, the rest VS2/SI1 on average.

One or two diamonds are slightly tinted yellow compared to the others. I-K range approx.

A few of the claws are worn and will need re-tipping.

Typical light scratching to the shank.

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
