An Improved Stone China Arabesque pattern blue printed part dinner service, probably Minton, 19th century, comprising tree and well meat platter, six graduated oval platters, two-handled footed centrepiece bowl, three vegetable dishes and four covers, two sauce tureens, covers, stands and ladles, footed circular stand, three rectangular dishes, twenty-three dinner plates, six dessert plates and nine smaller plates (faults and restoration), together with a silver mounted cut glass sugar sifter.

Estimate: £80 - £120

Condition Report

1418. Platters - minor staining to two smallest, crack to rim of other smaller platter, one larger platter cracked. Small plates - 6 with restoration, another chipped, 2 ok

Dessert plates - 2 chipped, others ok

Dinner plates - 4 chipped, 6 stained or heavily crazed, others ok

Small circular saucer - chip to rim

3 ladles - 1 broken, the other 2 stained/crazed

Sauce tureens - small chip to base of one

Vegetable tureens - 1 with chip to underside of rim

Two-handled centrepiece bowl - hairline and chip to rim, crazing.

All other pieces in fairly good condition with the occasional area of crazing or staining.
