A mixed group of English porcelain, 19th century, including a Minton trio, circa 1830, painted with pink roses, with a matching slop bowl and two-handled square plate, a Spode Felspar green ground cabinet cup and saucer, painted with floral panels, a Davenport cup and saucer, gilt with fruiting vine, a John Rose Coalport cabinet cup and saucer, painted with birds amidst foliate scrollwork against a blue ground, and a bat printed jug, together with two Dresden two-handed cups and a Sèvres style saucer (restored).

Condition Report

1595. Cobalt rimmed gilt floral cup - chipped rim, crack to handle

HR Daniel cup and saucer - both cracked

Minton creamer - cracked to base, staining to feet

Grainger dark green creamer - chipped handle terminal, crazed

Spill vase - cracked and gilding later touched up

Alcock yellow plate - cracked, crazed

Sèvres style saucer - restored

All the other pieces with fairly minor wear to gilding, very minor scratching, largely in good condition, no chips, cracks or repairs.
