A Derby porcelain lobed oval dish, early 19th century, painted with a titled view 'In Wales' in the style of George Robertson, the rim gilt with stylized urns, foliate scrollwork and anthemion, iron red painted marks to base, length 30.3cm, together with a Derby Japan pattern trio and four other 19th century porcelain cups and saucers (minor faults).

Estimate: £60 - £100

Condition Report

1640. Derby Wales dish - couple of small losses to the central scene, overall crazing to the piece. A small firing fault to the centre wheel has been covered by the central scene. Couple of nibbles to the rim which have possibly been later touched-up with gilt.

Derby Japan trio - saucer crazed, small chip to footrim, slight rubbing to gilt.

Pink/gilt cup/saucer - both crazed, some noticeable wear to the gilding.

Simple gilt exterior cup - small chip to foot

Printed scene cup/saucer - saucer with some scratching to central scene, wear to gilt rim. Cup with hairline crack to rim.

Other pieces fairly good condition.
