## LOT 1804

Two Moser amber tinted glass vases, 1930s, of waisted form, each decorated in silver and gilt with a four-horse-drawn stagecoach in a mountainous landscape setting, signed Freude, beneath gilt edged triangular cut rims and above faceted lower bodies, height 20cm (chips).

## **Condition Report**

One has a 2.3cm long flat chip to the top rim edge exterior which is 1.5cm wide at the widest point, it is just visible as a minor nick to the rim edge when you look down on the top rim circumference. In addition there is a pinhead sized bruise to the lower body near the foot. Otherwise this vase is in good condition. The other vase has 2 minor nicks to the base edge of the foot - otherwise it is in good condition. The decoration overall is in good order on both vases, with no signs of wear or rubbing.
