### LOT 1236

A late 19th century French lacquered brass carriage alarm clock by Margaine of Paris, with eight day movement striking hours, half hours and repeating on a gong, the backplate with stamped maker's mark and numbered '8964', the cream enameled dial with Arabic hour numerals and subsidiary alarm dial, the glazed case with reeded swing handle above Corinthian corner columns, on bracket feet, height 17.8cm.

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### Condition Report

1236. Clock in generally good condition. Case with typical surface scratches and wear to lacquer. Small chip to bottom right corner of front glass panel, other glass panels in good order. Dial in good order. The movement winds and adjusts smoothly, strike and repeat mechanism working as it should and the clock is currently running, but please be aware we give no guarantees to working order or reliability of any clock or watch.
