A Liberty Moorcroft Florian Ware Poppy pattern vase, circa 1898-1900, in shades of green, blue and yellow, green printed Liberty mark to base with green painted signature, height 20cm (minor faults to footrim).

Estimate: £300 - £500

Condition Report

Typical overall fine crazing to the glaze.

There is an approx 5cm long haircrack/firing crack to the inside edge of the footrim on the base of the vase, this has a fine haircrack running from it into the outside edge of the foot where it then joins an approx 7cm long slightly curved crack which runs along the outer edge of the foot. There is some very minor glaze loss along the crack on the outer edge of the foot.

Positioned almost on the opposite side of the foot exterior is an approx 3cm long curve shaped crack.

Otherwise the vase has no other damage and no restoration.
