A craquelure ice glass jug with entwined red snake handle, Bohemian or French, circa 1850, with gilt details, height 32cm, together with a large mixed group of craquelure ice glass, including a large pair of baluster shape vases, height 41cm, two jugs with ice compartments, a tulip shaped trumpet vase, height 33.5cm, a three-footed dish with central trumpet shaped epergne and two ice buckets of pail shape (minor faults). Provenance: from the collection of John and Poppy Stallebrass.

Estimate: £80 - £120

Condition Report

The red snake has lost most of its gilt detail.

The trumpet epergne fitting has lost its end and is not held in place properly or securely.

The jugs with ice compartments are both in good condition.

Otherwise the items in the lot are generally in good condition overall with no significant damage or repairs.
