LOT 1581

A Royal Worcester reticulated jug, dated 1875, the double-walled body pierced with an aesthetic trellis design heightened in gilt dotted borders with red and pale blue enamel detail, the neck with turquoise 'jewelled' stylized flowers and gilt foliage, the handle in the form of bamboo, green printed factory mark to base, height 13cm (minor faults).

Estimate: £120 - £180

Condition Report

There is an approx 1cm square flat chip to neck top rim exterior.

A small section of the piercing beneath the handle is 'pushed-in' a little where the piercing has broken a tiny bit during manufacture.

A small triangular shaped section of piercing is missing from one of the panels with the red detail - only noticeable on close inspection.
