### LOT 1926

Five double series opaque twist stem wine glasses, circa 1770, comprising a cup shaped bowl, a pan-topped rounded funnel bowl, a flute, an ogee bowl with everted rim and a rounded funnel bowl, each with conical foot, tallest 16.3cm (chips). Provenance: Arthur Henry Green, a private collector from Enfield, died 1953. Thence by descent.

Estimate: £150 - £250

### Condition Report

Cup bowl - diameter of foot 7.3cm, there is a small chip to the underside edge of the foot. The stem has a slightly milky appearance.

Pan-topped - diameter of foot 7cm, the glass overall displays a number of raindrop like inclusions.

Flute - diameter of foot 7cm, there is a nibbled chip to the edge of the foot and two very small chips to the underside edge of the foot.

Ogee - diameter of foot 6.8cm, there is small chip to the underside edge of the foot and two small nicks to the foot edge.

Rounded funnel - diameter of foot 7.4cm, bowl has a sizable chip to the rim and some scratches.
