A Hamilton Automatic 9ct gold circular cased gentleman's wristwatch with signed and jewelled 63 caliber movement, the signed silvered dial with gilt baton hour markers, Arabic '12' and centre seconds, London 1963, case diameter 3.3cm, together with a Certina Blue Ribbon Automatic steel cased gentleman's wristwatch, the signed silvered dial with baton hour markers, centre seconds and date aperture, the case back numbered '5801 100 4712757', case diameter 3.3cm.
