A Seiko 'Bullhead' Chronograph Automatic stainless steel gentleman's bracelet wristwatch, Ref. 6138-0040, circa November 1976, with signed and jewelled 61398 caliber movement, the signed black dial with luminous baton hour markers, two blue subsidiary dials and day and date apertures at 6 o'clock, the signed case back detailed '6138-0040' and '6N3147', the bracelet with signed foldover clasp, case diameter 4.4cm, with Seiko box.

Condition Report

1087. The watch is in generally good condition. Typical light surface scratches and wear, but no significant damage or repairs.

Good clean dial.

Bracelet good and clasp in good working order.

The watch winds and adjust smoothly, day and date roll over as they should and it is currently running, but please be aware we give no guarantees to working order or reliability of any clock or watch.

The chrono feature is partially working, it starts and stops with the left button exactly as it should, but the hand does not always return to the upright (its erratic) when the right button is pressed.

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
