A Royal Worcester Japanesque déjeuner service milk jug and cover, dated 1874, of aesthetic form, the square shaped body moulded in low relief with bamboo, a foliate branch and two butterflies, with lizard handle, raised on four feet, impressed and puce printed marks to base, height 15cm (minor faults).

Estimate: £120 - £180

Condition Report

One of the feet has two chips, one of the chips looks as though it has probably been there since manufacture as it is painted over with the exact colour of the rest of the foot.

The dragon handle has two pinhead sized nicks to 2 of the tiny relief points on its back.

The finial of the cover has been reglued through its waisted section and there are some teeny tiny losses of glaze along the break line.

Otherwise in good condition overall.

No crazing.

The enamels and gilding are good.
