### LOT 1166

A late 19th century American Seth Thomas brass circular ship's timepiece with eight day movement, the 8½-inch silvered dial with black Arabic hour numerals, slow/fast indicator and subsidiary seconds, detailed 'S.T.' above 'W.M Anderson Philadelphia, PA. Star Brass MFG. Co. Boston Mass.' and numbered '968', the case with glazed front door, case diameter 26.8cm, with winding key.

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### Condition Report

1166. The case in generally good condition with typical surface scratches and wear. Hinge and push button door release are good. Dial with typical wear and scratches, but otherwise generally good order. Unfortunately, neither train of the movement winds and it does not run at all.

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
