A Victorian 18ct gold cased keywind open-faced gentleman's pocket watch, the gilt fusee movement detailed 'Clarkson North Allerton' and numbered '23305', with gilt metal dust cover, the enamelled dial with black Roman hour numerals, the case back with floral engraved decoration, Chester 1863, total weight 123.4g, case diameter 5.1cm, together with a 9ct gold graduated curb link Albert watch chain, fitted with two swivels, weight 47.7g, total length 42cm, and a watch key.

Estimate: £1,500 - £2,000

Condition Report

1085. The watch is a little tired. The case with typical surface scratches and wear to engraving. Few dents to edge and case back gapes a bit when closed. The movement winds and starts ticking but please be aware we give no guarantees to working order or reliability of any clock or watch. Enamel dial in good condition. Gilt metal dust cover slightly misshapen but fits.

The two lengths of gold Albert chain with typical light surface scratches and wear.

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
