A group of six Chinese Peking glass bowls, late Qing dynasty, comprising rose pink, green, blue, black and yellow opaque bowls, each of circular form with flared rim, diameters ranging from 10.9cm to 12.3cm, and a green translucent bowl, diameter 10.7cm (chip to rim of pink and black bowls).

Condition Report

1104. Blue bowl - good condition, no chips, cracks or repairs. Typical light surface scratches.

Pink bowl - chip to rim, otherwise ok.

Yellow bowl - good condition, no chips, cracks or repairs.

Green opaque bowl - generally good condition, no chips, cracks or repairs. Small bubble/blister imperfection to edge of rim.

Green translucent - good condition, no chips, cracks or repairs.

Black bowl - small chip to rim, otherwise good condition.
