A collection of Chinese Peking glass, late Qing dynasty, comprising three translucent amber wine cups and two saucers, height 5cm, amber bowl, diameter 11.5cm, ruby bowl, ruby small dish, blue bowl (cracked) and four small saucers, pale blue/turquoise bowl and two stands (minor faults).

Condition Report

1103. 3 x amber wine cups - good condition, no chips, cracks or repairs. One with hairline blemish to rim, another with tiny nick, all with slightly uneven surface.

2 x amber saucers - one with tiny nick to rim, all with slightly uneven surface.

Amber bowl - good condition, no chips, cracks or repairs.

Red bowl - good condition, no chips, cracks or repairs.

Small ruby dish - good condition.

Blue bowl - crack and chip to rim with crack running down into the body.

4 x small blue saucers - good condition.

Turquoise bowl - good condition.

2 x turquoise stands/dishes - good condition.
