A mid to late 18th century flintlock pistol, probably Continental, with round barrel, barrel length 24.5cm, and shaped and part-decorated lock and mechanism, full-stocked with cast brass decorated furniture and later pull-out ramrod (repairs, losses and alterations).

Estimate: £80 - £120

Condition Report

4826. Pistol in our opinion is late 18th century. It has replaced parts, but done a long time ago, a new steel band has been wrapped around forend of gun as well as a new piece of brass near muzzle. Overall looks an honest gun with some later tidying. Trigger cocks at half and full cock, though very tight. Some later pins to trigger guard and inset brass crescent lacking from grip area.
