Condition Report

There is a minuscule nick to the base outer edge of the foot, only noticeable on very close inspection, next to a manufacturer's glazed over rough spot. Otherwise the vase is in good condition with no damage or repairs. There are some long typical craze lines around the neck and shoulders.
