A Clarice Cliff Original Bizarre pattern vase, 1920s, painted with a geometric design of blue and red triangles outlined in green against a yellow ground, gilt printed mark to base, height 18cm, with a matched lamp fitting (minor faults).

Estimate: £70 - £100

Condition Report

There is a very faint starcrack to the base.

The later lamp fitting was attached using three screws to tighten the fitting to the short blue upright neck of the vase, there are consequently three small depressions in the glaze of the neck corresponding with these screws - please see the images on our website. There is also some very minor wear around the neck where the fitting was attached.

Otherwise there are some minor scratches/digs to the enamels overall, nothing terrible.
