An unusual Chelsea porcelain Mazarine blue ground teacup and saucer, gold anchor period, circa 1760, both pieces painted with five panels of children within gilt foliate framed arched panels above a gilt trellis border, the entwined handle with foliate terminals, gilt dentil rims, gold painted anchor mark to bases, diameter of saucer 13.8cm (cup cracked). Note: two similar cups were sold at Bonhams Knightsbridge, 20th May 2015, Lot 92.

Condition Report

The cup has a vertical crack running from the rim towards the lower handle terminal. Otherwise both pieces are in good condition with no cracks, chips or restoration. There is typical wear commensurate with age and handling, nothing untoward.
