A gold, platinum and diamond cluster ring, mounted with the principal old cut cushion shaped diamond within a surround of ten smaller old cut cushion shaped diamonds, detailed '18ct', weight 1.9g, ring size approx M1/2.

Condition Report

684. The ring is in generally good condition with no significant damage or repairs. The diamonds are bright, white and sparkly. Principal diamond has a surface reaching inclusion to one of the side facets visible under x10 magnification. Some of the surrounding stones have minor pique inclusions. Suggested age is 1920-1930s. Diameter of the top cluster 0.9cm.
