Jimi Hendrix - Axis

Vinyl - scuffs and hairlines, no feelable scratchers, quite glossy overall.

Sleeve - minor laminate creasing extending in from edges, no more than 2cm max. Scuffing at corners. 2cm scuff to spine and 2 smaller scuffs. Laminate good.

Insert - present, good.

Who - A Quick One

Side 1 - unfeelable diagonal scratch across tracks 2, 3 and 3. Unfeelable scratch on track 6.

Side 2 - Good

Spindle marks to labels, some creases to sleeve, no poster, owner's initials to inside of outer sleeve.

Who - My Generation

No feelable scratches, hairlines, dull sheen, spindle marks on labels, rear of sleeve discoloured, owner's initials below catalogue number.

Stickly Fingers

Side 2 - heavy scuffs to tracks 3 and 4, spindle marks, small zip, insert present.

Disraeli Gears

Hairlines, overall smart, spindle mark, sleeve good, owner's initials to inside of outer sleeve.
