A pair of Chinese blue and white export porcelain plates, Kangxi period, painted with flowers and rocks, diameter 22cm (one with hairline crack to rim), together with a Chinese blue and white export porcelain circular dish, Kangxi period, painted with two geese, rocks and lotus in landscape within a segmented border, diameter 20.7cm (hairline cracks to rim), and a Chinese provincial blue and white ginger jar, painted with a coastal landscape, height 20cm (cracked).

Estimate: £60 - £100

Condition Report

1037. Kangxi dish - numerous hairline cracks to the rim, some minor chips/losses along some of the cracks. Otherwise no restoration, typical surface scratches to glaze. Good colours.

Plate 1 - 4cm hairline to rim, typical light surface scratches to glaze, otherwise ok.

Plate 2 - no chips, cracks or repairs. Typical light surface scratches to glaze and few tiny nicks to rim but nothing significant.

Jar - there is a horizontal crack which runs 2/3 of the way around the middle of the jar and a star crack to the base, otherwise typical light surface scratches to glaze.
