A Chinese blue and white porcelain vase, Kangxi period, of baluster form, painted with flowering branches and rocks, height 22cm (chip to footrim), together with a Chinese blue and white porcelain teapot and cover, Kangxi period, of rectangular form, painted with opposing landscape panels, flowers and precious objects, height 12.9cm (handle repaired, glaze fritting and chips).

Estimate: £200 - £300

Condition Report

1077. Teapot - handle has been broken off into 4 pieces and reglued, small chip to rim. Glaze fritting/loss along edges at top and bottom of the teapot. Typical light surface scratches and wear to glaze. Cover in good condition.

Vase - small chip to footrim, otherwise good condition with no other chips, cracks or repairs. Typical light surface scratches and wear to glaze.
