Condition Report

1079. Famille rose caddy - chip to one corner of caddy and a smaller chip/scuff to another corner, minor glaze scuff to rim, otherwise caddy is in generally good condition with no cracks or repairs. Nice vibrant enamels. Cover with 3 small chips to rim and minor nicks to leaf finial.

Imari caddy - 1.5cm x 1cm chip to top corner of caddy, otherwise good condition with only minor glaze fritting to some edges. Typical light surface scratches to glaze. Cover in good condition, typical light wear to gilt.
