A small group of Chinese famille rose export porcelain, Qianlong period, comprising a teapot and cover with replacement handle, height 14.5cm, and a sparrow beak cream jug and cover, height 12.2cm, each painted with figural scenes, and a tankard painted with flowers, height 12.8cm (cracked), together with a Canton famille rose circular plate, late 19th century, painted with panels of figures, birds and flowers, diameter 23.8cm.

Condition Report

1089. Teapot - replacement wicker and metal handle, minor nicks to end of spout, minor glaze fritting to rim of cover. Gilt on spout, body and cover is heavily worn. Enamels are bright and vibrant.

Cream jug - generally good condition, no chips, cracks or repairs. Typical light surface scratches and wear to enamels and glaze.

Tankard - crack to rim running vertically the whole length and across the base (approx 22.5cm in length). Crack to bottom of handle. No chips or restoration. Typical minor wear to enamels.

Canton dish - generally good condition, typical light surface scratches and wear to glaze, enamels and gilt. No cracks or repairs.
