### LOT 1112

A Chinese Canton famille rose medallion porcelain teapot and cover, mid-19th century, of cylindrical form, typically painted with birds and flowers, height 14.8cm, together with a collection of other similarly decorated famille rose porcelain, late 19th century and early 20th century, including cups, saucers and plates (some faults).

### Condition Report

1112. Teapot - generally good condition, two very minor chips to inner rim but no cracks or repairs.

Two handled cup and cover - one handle broken off and missing, otherwise ok.

Jug - missing handle, otherwise ok.

Three shallow cups - good condition, no chips, cracks or repairs.

Seven other cups - six with hairline cracks, one in good condition.

Six larger saucers - good condition with no chips, cracks or repairs.

Four smaller fluted saucers - all with rim chips.

Three other saucers - two cracked and one chipped.

Bowl - chip to rim, otherwise ok.

Eleven fluted plates - eight in good condition with no chips, cracks or repairs. One is cracked and two with small rim chips.

All of the service has typical light surface scratches and wear to enamels and gilt. It is also a bit dirty so would benefit from a clean.
