A pair of Chinese famille rose export porcelain plates, Qianlong period, each painted and gilt with a central peony and fruiting Buddha's hand citron within a floral decorated rim, diameter 23.2cm (each with hairline crack and rim chips), together with a Chinese blue and white export porcelain plate, 18th century, painted with landscape and flowers, diameter 21.9cm (minor rim chips/fritting).

Condition Report

1059. Pair of plates - typical rubbing to enamels and gilt on both, one with 4.5cm hairline to rim, the other with 3cm and 2.5cm hairlines to rim.

Blue and white plate - minor rim chips, typical light surface scratches to glaze.

All three with glaze fritting to rims.
