Two Moorcroft pottery ginger jars and covers, the first in the Gustavia Augusta pattern, dated 1999, designed by Debbie Hancock, the second in the Tree Peony pattern, dated 2004, designed by Philip Gibson, both with impressed, printed and painted marks to bases, height 15cm.

Estimate: £120 - £180

Condition Report

Tree Peony example probably a factory seconds as the Gibson printed mark to the base has a concave mark over it - when you inspect the jar closely there are some light surface scratches over one of the larger flower petals.

Otherwise both are in good condition with no cracks, chips or restoration. No glaze crazing.
