LOT 1820

Seven assorted Art Deco glass cocktail shakers and stoppers, first half 20th century, each enamelled and/or silvered and gilt with cockerels', tallest 24cm, together with a mixed group of other mostly Art Deco style glass, including conical shaped wines, another cocktail shaker and stopper enamelled with a duck, decanters and some stoppers, a circular pale blue glass tray engraved with a stylized figure, diameter 28cm, a pale blue glass decanter and stopper and six matching shot glasses (some faults). Provenance: from the collection of John and Poppy Stallebrass.

Estimate: £120 - £180

Condition Report

Two of the largest amber footed cocktail glasses have miniscule nicks to the outer top rim edge.

One of the faceted blue glasses that has a matching cocktail shaker with plated mounts has a minor nick to the top rim edge.

Squat decanter gilt with a dancing lady is missing its stopper.

Pale blue decanter with cylindrical neck missing stopper.

Set six small pale blue cocktail glasses with matching decanter and stopper - one glass with tiny nick to top rim edge. The neck of the decanter is angled, I'm not sure this is an original feature.

Tray with minuscule blemish to inner rim edge.

The decanters and stoppers are generally all in good order - there are some very minor nicks to the stoppers or covers overall, but these are few and very inconsequential. One with a pair of fighting cockerels has a minor chip to the top rim edge, and the one with one very large cockerel has some more significant chipping to the base end of its stopper.
