A mid-19th century French gilt brass mantel clock with eight day movement striking on a bell via an outside countwheel, the white enameled circular dial with blue Roman hour numerals and outer black Arabic minutes, the drum case with urn surmount and lion mask drop ring handles, on foliate scroll moulded supports flanking acanthus festoon and fret panels, on an inverted breakfront base, height 40.5cm, with pendulum and winding key.

1136. The clock is in generally good clean restored condition. Dial in good order.

The clock is not currently running - it starts to run but does not maintain after a couple of minutes or so. The strike mechanism is working.
