A George V oak longcase clock with eight day movement striking hours on a large gong and chiming on six smaller gongs, the 11-inch square brass dial with black Roman hour numerals, subsidiary seconds and inscribed 'Maple London', the hood with barley twist columns, the trunk and base with geometric mouldings, on bracket feet, height 207cm, with pendulum and three weights.

Estimate: £150 - £250

Condition Report

1162. Generally good condition, very much as can be seen in the online images.

Case a little tired with some wear to polish in places. Split to base panel and small split to top of door, but no significant damage.

Dial with some typical scratches and wear.

Movement is a bit dusty and dirty so would benefit from a clean/overhaul, but all appears to be present.

The clock came in to us from storage and train chains are loose and detached from pulleys, so unable to tell you if it is currently in good working order.

3 weights and pendulum present.
