A 19th century French gilt lacquered brass carriage timepiece with eight day movement, the backplate detailed 'De La Combe Hger a Paris', the white enameled dial with black Roman hour numerals, the case with cast lunette borders, foliate scroll swing handle, bevelled glass panels and winged feet, height 20.7g, with winding key.

Condition Report

1126. Generally good condition with no significant damage or repairs. Typical light surface scratches and wear but nothing of any real significance. Minor chips to corners of one glass side panel, otherwise glass panels in good order. Dial in good condition.

The movement wind smoothly and is currently running, but please be aware we give no guarantees to working order or reliability of any clock or watch.

Movement is slightly loose in the case, so needs securing properly.

Height including handle 20.7cm, width 10.8cm, depth 9cm.

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
