### LOT 1140

A Victorian walnut bracket clock with eight day twin fusee movement striking on two bells, the 8-inch silvered dial with black Roman hour numerals and signed 'Thwaites & Reed London', the case with stepped top above bevelled glass side panels, on a cushion plinth base, height 47cm, with pendulum and case key. Note: Thwaites & Reed are recorded London clockmakers, founded in 1740 and running to this day, claiming to be the oldest clock manufacturing company in the world.

Estimate: £250 - £350

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### Condition Report

1140. Case needs attention as gapping to corner joints, chip to one corner of moulding and minor chips to edges of veneers. Glass front door has a broken catch so does not stay closed. Dial is heavily scratched and worn.

Both trains of the movement wind smoothly, strike mechanism in good working order and it is currently running, but please be aware we give no guarantees to working order or reliability of any clock or watch.

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
