A Victorian 18ct gold, half-pearl and foiled back emerald cluster ring with scroll pierced split shoulders, Birmingham 1867, weight 1.6g, ring size approx L, a Victorian gold, emerald and diamond three stone ring with scrolled shoulders, unmarked, ring size approx N1/2, and a gold and emerald single stone ring with filigree decoration, unmarked, ring size approx M1/2, total weight 3.9g, with three cases.

Condition Report

574. 18ct gold half-pearl and foil backed emerald ring - the gold mount in generally good order with typical surface wear to setting. Central pearl is good with only typical light surface scratches, but no damage. Some variation to colour of emeralds, one with chip and crack, all with surface wear and abrasions and many with minor nicks and chips.

Emerald and diamond three stone ring - small repair to shank where it meets shoulder, otherwise typical surface scratches and wear. Typical surface wear to claw settings and small chip to edge of emerald and minor nicks to edges of diamonds.

Gold and emerald single stone ring - some misshaping to filigree surround, otherwise typical light surface scratches and wear. Small crack and wear to edge of stone surround. Emerald with surface reaching inclusions and typical light surface scratches and wear.

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
