A mid-19th century gold and micromosaic ring, the oval panel designed as a dove with wings raised against a blue ground, between beaded sides and a conjoined twin shank, weight 2.5g, ring size approx J1/2 (minor faults).

Estimate: £80 - £120

Condition Report

506. Generally good order. Few pieces of tessera missing to the oval panel (visible in image 2 on our website, image can be enlarged as required).

Gold mount in generally good condition, small solder repair to shoulder on one side where shank meets oval panel, otherwise mount with just typical light surface scratches, wear and slightly misshapen shank.

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
