A pair of Chinese Canton famille rose porcelain vases, mid to late 19th century, each ovoid body painted with opposing figural panels within gilt keyfret framing, reserved against a ground of flowers, butterflies and precious objects, the similarly decorated flared neck applied with gilt chilong and Buddhist lion handles, height 23cm (minor rim chips).

### Condition Report

1105. Vase 1 - good condition with no significant damage or repairs. Typical light surface scratches and wear to gilt and enamels, more pronounced wear to gilt on chilong and handles. Minor enamel loss. Small glaze blemish/shallow chip to body.

Vase 2 - chip to underside of rim and minor glaze fritting to rim, otherwise in good condition with no other significant damage or repairs. Typical light surface scratches and wear to gilt and enamels and more pronounced wear to gilt on chilong and handles. Minor enamel loss.
