A pair of Chinese famille rose porcelain vases, late Qing dynasty, each shouldered tapering body and flared neck painted with battle scenes, height 30.7cm (repaired).

Condition Report

1266. Both vases in need of extensive restoration.

Vase 1 - broken into numerous pieces and partially re-glued. Some filler present and some losses/chips along break lines. Decoration is bright and vibrant. Sellotape present where holding certain parts of the vase together.

Vase 2 - broken in half around the neck/shoulder and re-glued, other cracks to body. Sellotape present where helping to keep vase intact. Decoration is bright and vibrant.

Typical light surface scratches and wear to glaze and enamels.
